Above numbers are percentages of student who met or exceeded standards on the 2005-2006 State Assessments.

This is a comparative Analysis of regional middle schools: Tumalo Community School (K-8), Obsidian, Terrebonne Community School (K-7 last year, but K-8 this year), and Hugh Hartman in Redmond; Pilot Butte, Sky View, Cascade, Westside Village Magnet (K-8) in Bend, La Pine Middle School and Jefferson Middle School in Madras. The average state wide scores are listed in the far right column.

Sisters Middle School outperforms area schools with the exception of Cascade Middle School in Bend and in some areas, Westside Village. Terrebonne Community School 6th grade scores are outstanding. Note that the sample groups for Terrebonne and Tumalo are very small with less than 30 students in each middle school grade. Westside Village is a small magnet school.
